## From Guidance

If a student would like a scholarship they received acknowledged in the graduation program they must submit documentation (proof) to Mr. Harris, Mrs. Vautour or Mrs. Dominic in Guidance.

The proof can be a letter or email received from the organization with the name of the scholarship and amount, and must be done before the end of classes on June 6<sup>th</sup>.

Graduating students who are going to college or university in the Fall **must** make arrangements to have their final transcripts sent to the institution they plan on attending. This can be done by filling out the Orange Final Transcript Request Form available in guidance or at the main office. When the form is completed, please bring it to the office.

Some of our upcoming grad events are as follows. Next week on Tuesday May 13<sup>th</sup> from 6:30- 8:30PM, we will be having a grad paint night in the art room where students will be able to participate in guided imagery led by Ms Takacs. The entrance is free for the students who have already signed up in advance. The following week, on Monday May 19<sup>th</sup> from 4:00-7:00PM will be a paintball night for graduates who have signed up to participate. In order to participate students will need to sign a waiver which will be provided in advance to the day of paintball and the cost is \$40 per student.
