Breakout Sessions Descriptions

East Coast Trades College:

East Coast Trades College focuses on hands-on learning in the vocational trades sector, offering a diverse range of trade programs. This private institution emphasizes the development of practical, real-world skills crucial for students to succeed in their chosen trades. Through industry partnerships, East Coast Trades College provides students with essential hands-on experience three days a week, balancing this with two days of classroom instruction per week. This immersive approach enriches their skill set, preparing them to excel in the fast-paced and competitive trades industry.

Horizon School of Radiography Moncton:

The Horizon School of Radiography Moncton Campus partners with UNB Saint John to offer a four-year Bachelor of Health Sciences in Radiography, with students completing two years at UNBSJ followed by two years of specialized training in Moncton. Students enter the BHS program at UNBSJ, apply to the competitive Radiography major during their first year, and, if accepted, continue with three additional years of academic and clinical education. Year 2 includes health science coursework at UNBSJ, while Years 3 and 4 focus on radiography theory and hands-on clinical training at The Moncton Hospital. Graduates become radiologic technologists skilled in a wide range of imaging procedures, including x-rays, CT scans, mammography, fluoroscopy, and interventional radiology.
