

Dear Grads and Families,

We are about 4 weeks away from Graduation! Although some of this information has already been sent, there are a few additions and action items to keep in mind.

Bursaries and Scholarships:

If your grad has received any scholarships or bursaries (including entrance to post-secondary), they are asked to send an email to their school counsellor before June 5th so it can be recognized in the graduation program. Enter GRADUATION SCHOLARSHIP in the subject line and attach proof of the rewarded amount.

Grad Night:

Graddies will take place on Thursday, May 28th with supper beginning at 5:30pm in the cafeteria to celebrate our graduates. This night is dedicated solely to our grads and includes supper, entertainment, and prizes. Students must purchase a ticket in advance.

Prom:

Prom will take place on Tuesday, June 16th, at the Crowne Plaza from 7:00 pm until 10:00 pm. The theme this year is Masquerade Ball.

Guest passes for prom tickets are on sale for \$25 in the main lobby at lunch time.

Graduation, Tickets, and Accessibility Needs:

Graduation is scheduled for Thursday, June 18th, at the Tidal Church, formerly known as Wesleyan Celebration Center. The doors will open at 6:00 pm, with the ceremony beginning at 7:00 pm.

On Friday, June 12th at the rehearsal, we ask each grad to request the number of tickets required for each family to attend graduation. We try to grant each grad 5 tickets; however, more tickets may be available for distribution on that day of rehearsal. Please let your child know how many they should request.

Mandatory Grad Practices:

All graduates are required to attend mandatory grad practices during exam week in the BMHS theatre. These will be on Monday, June 8th, Wednesday, June 10th, and Friday, June 12th from 11:45am- 12:45pm. The final rehearsal will be on the morning of graduation at the Tidal Church, formerly the Wesleyan Celebration Center at 8:45am.

Graduation Gowns:

Graduation gowns will be distributed on Friday, June 12th between 11:45am and 12:45 pm in ROOM 167. This includes a gown, V-stole sash, cap and tassel. A \$20 cash deposit is required to pick up the gown and all fees owing/uniforms/books etc. must be returned/paid/up to date. Gowns and V-Stoles must be returned at the Tidal Church immediately after the ceremony.

Forms and Fees:

We ask that all graduates/families sign off on the "Grade 12 RTIPPA 2025-2026" form online in School Cash.

This year's grad fee of \$140 can be paid via SchoolCash Online. This fee covers the cost of the venue, audio/visual, decorations, diplomas, programs, and the grad gowns and caps. You can access SchoolCash at <https://angloeast.schoolcashionline.com/>.

Graduates received a copy of their "Statement of Fees Owing" in Homeroom at the start of May. We will be sending another reminder home soon via email. Check School Cash Online to see what fees might be outstanding.
